



- Homecoming Details & Competitions










Unarmed & Armed Drill

- Cadets will be perform the 30-Step Flight Drill Sequence learned during class


Raider Team C/ SMSgt Spaeth

In **UAS** (**Unmanned Aircraft System**) cadets will learn about, operate, race, compete, and perform maintenance on UASs.

- Missions: Flown in support of a request, such as video coverage for football, band, school administrators, etc.
- Practice time may be utilized to prepare cadets for the knowledge needed so they can take their test for their Federal Aviation Administration Remote Pilot Certificate





Flight Academy C/ 2 Lt Schaat



The Air Force JROTC **Flight Academy** is an approximately 8-week summer aviation training program, conducted at partnering universities nationwide. Upon successful completion of the program, students are awarded a Private Pilot's Certification.

TX-20081 Provides tutoring for cadets interested in applying for this scholarship program.
